

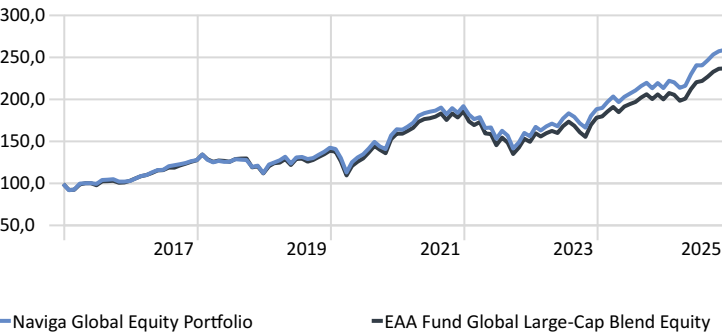
INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE

INVESTMENT GROWTH

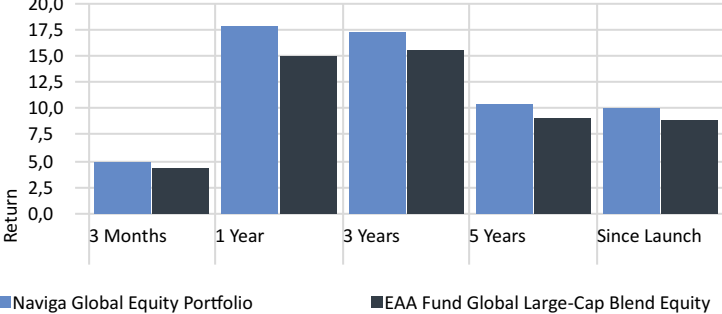

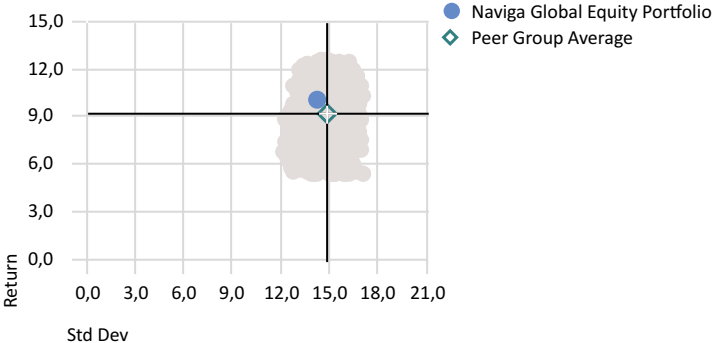

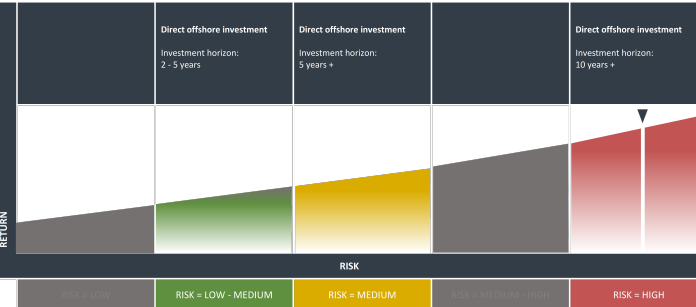

HIGH

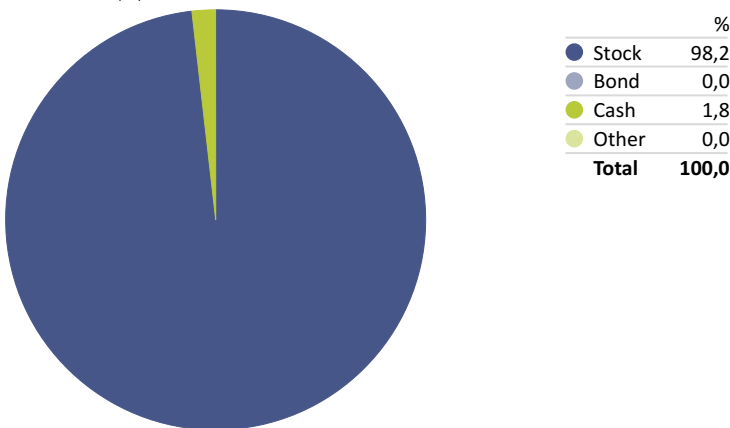

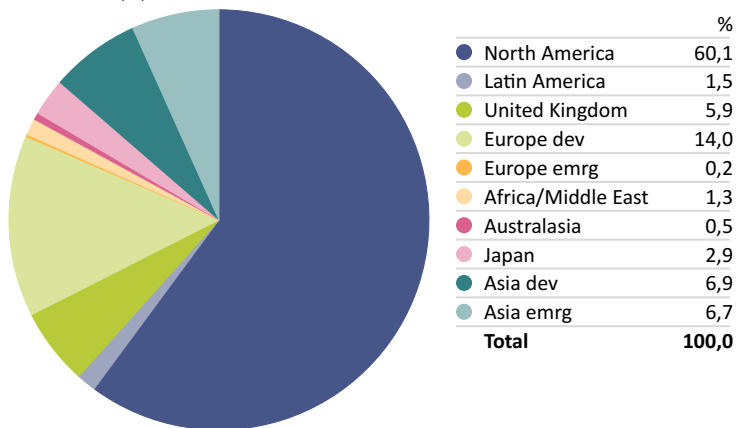
## ASSET ALLOCATION
